Annual Request Information

1. Background: Review and discuss the context of the proposed technology in detail. Explain how this proposal will be used in conjunction with an original proposal or existing technology. If applicable, how is the current technology disabled or inadequate?

This proposal is a continuation of the equipment available in the STF Student Equipment Checkout pool, as well as backup and replacements for previously purchased equipment. It contains both updated models on previous requests, due to popularity and quantity demands, as well as new models and categories, due to feedback from the students on equipment capabilities and expectations.

2. Benefit to Students: Discuss how students have benefited from the original proposal, if applicable. How will additional funding of the technology benefit students? If this was an unforeseen technology need, discuss how students will benefit from this new proposal and why the need cannot wait for annual allocation funding.

The first item is a request for a lighter digital camera kit, due to student feedback and requests. Our previous model Nikon kits are still available, though are larger, heavier and contain additional parts that may not be needed in every situation. This kit contains a digital mirrorless camera, a kit lens, and a fast prime lens to be able to shoot in a variety of lighting situations without needing to carry additional equipment. The image quality and sensor size is the same as existing equipment, but in a smaller footprint.

The Canon VIXIA video cameras are an ongoing popular item. This will add additional cameras for availability, as well as updating to the most current model

The Sennheiser wireless microphone kits, as well as the Yeti USB and Zoom digital audio recorders are also requested to update older / discontinued models in the current checkout pool. The Zoom recorders provide a simple recorder that can be used for a variety of uses, including lecture capture and audio / video production. The Yeti USB microphone is an improved quality to previously purchased USB models.

The Epson data projector models would provide the students with their first Full HD available model, as well as provide a much more affordable lamp cost replacement versus previously purchased items. A variety of devices can be connected for student presentations, self-guided events and personal home usage.

VR and 360 video has proliferated the market, and with the Insta360 request, this would give students access to the ability to create this content. The technology is used in a wide array of fields, from educational content to medical practices. This kit provides the most flexible and highest quality at an entry price point.

For the last new line item, a popular request that has come through the Helpdesk is for gimbals. These can be used with the majority of smart phones and provides stabilized and professional looking video footage without the need for additional expensive equipment.

The remaining equipment list is for replacement and backup equipment for the most commonly used accessories.

All currently registered students will have access to this and other previously approved STF equipment. The equipment is available at the IT Helpdesk, located in the WG 108 Computer Lab. The current checkout duration is one week, with no reservations, to ensure equipment availability. Due to the increase in faculty assigned production products, there has been a larger demand for the existing equipment inventory. This proposal would provide a supplement to times of higher demand, as well as changing standards. As per Joshua Gibson, Client and Technical Services Manager, there were 723 equipment checkouts in the last year.

4. Timeline: Provide a timeline showing how the proposed technology can be completed during the requested period. Describe when you would like to see this proposal initiated and completed, and why.

If funding is provided, equipment can be ordered, received, tested, inventoried and deployed in a few weeks. The Summer Quarter provides the Student Technicians time to familiarize themselves with the new equipment, to be able to assist student requests and inquiries on usage. Full equipment deployment would be available in Fall Quarter.

The STF Checkout Equipment is managed by the IT Helpdesk, with the positions held by STF-funded Student Technicians. They provide assistance for equipment checkout, basic training and maintenance, including charging and cleaning. Additional support for post-production, as well as more advanced equipment usage is available in the CP 005 Multimedia Lab. Media Services staff is always available for additional assistance, including more involved checkout equipment usage, planning for event support and any technical issues that may arise. Information Technology has the WebCheckout system, which provides check-in, check-out, inventory, statistics and notification capabilities.

Equipment prices have been provided with a relatively safe amount, to account for price and model fluctuations. As with previous proposals, the purchase price could be lower than the requested amount.
